The doctor goes with a translator via boat or Gojek.

Villagers are seen for free and medicine is also free.

Amount of village clinics done from March - December 2019: 36 clinics (1 clinic per week)

Number of patients examined and treated: 950 patients (average 20 – 35 per clinic)

Medical problems are anything from heart, skin, lungs, ears, nose, throat, abdominal, musculo-skeletal and vision problems

Everyone is seen: babies, children, adults and older people.

- 2] Continue free Cataract surgery for blind people
- 3] Donations will be asked for to buy a boat for Pagai Foundation:
 - This boat will be used to do more clinics and also to do projects like diving to clean the ocean of plastics

- 5] Help community
 - Generators
 - Solar panels
 - Water purifiers
 - Solar energy
