A. Background

F. Criteria and Requirements

Criteria and Requirements in Circular Letter Number 7 of 2020 regarding Criteria and Requirements for Travel of People during the Adaptation Period toward New Habits to Promote a Productive and Safe Community in Consideration of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is amended to:

1. Every individual who travels is obliged to apply and adhere to health protocols such as wearing masks, keeping a distance, and washing hands as a travel criteria.
2. Domestic travel requirements:
 - a. Every individual who travels in a private vehicle is responsible for their own health, and is subject to and must comply with the applicable terms and conditions;
 - b. Every individual who travels on land, rail, sea and air public transportation must meet the following requirements:
 - 1) Showing their identity (KTP or other valid identification);
 - 2) Showing a PCR test certificate with negative results or a Rapid-Test test certificate with non-reactive results that remains valid for 14 days from the time of departure;
 - 3) Showing a symptom-free certificate for illness such as influenza (influenza-like illness) issued by the Doctor of the Hospital/Public Health Office for areas that do not have PCR Test and/or Rapid-Test facilities.
 - c. Domestic travel requirements are exempted for the travel of people using commuter and travel of people within the agglomeration area/region.

- d. Download and activate the Peduli Lindungi application on mobile devices.

3. Travel requirements for people arriving from abroad:
- a. Every individual who comes from abroad must submit and obey the applied terms and conditions:
 - 1) every individual who comes from abroad must get a PCR test at the time of arrival, if the concerned person has not been tested before arrival and/or cannot show the PCR test from the country of departure;
 - 2) PCR test requirements for foreign arrivals are excluded from the Cross Country Border Posts (PLBN) which do not have PCR equipment, by conducting a rapid test and showing a symptom-free certificate from illness such as influenza (influenza-like illness) issued by the Hospital Doctor/Health authority.
 - b. during the waiting period for PCR Test results, each person must be quarantined at a special quarantine accommodation provided by the government; or
 - c. utilize quarantine accommodation (Hotels/Lodging) that have received certification of COVID-19 quarantine accommodation from the Ministry of Health;
 - d. download and activate the Peduli Lindungi application on mobile phone devices

This Circular Letter is effective from the date of stipulation, and can be changed in accordance with the development of the situation, and it ends when there is a new Presidential Decree that terminates the Presidential Decree Number 11 of 2020 regarding the Stipulation of Public Health Emergency due to the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
