**THE NUMBER OF SURFERS THAT CAN SURF IN  
THE AREA WITH LIMITED CARRYING CAPACITY**

**REGENT OF MENTAWAI ISLANDS**

Considering : that in accordance to the provisions of Article 2 of Regent Regulation No. 13 on Guidelines for Implementation of Regional Regulations of Mentawai Islands Regency Number 2 of 2015 concerning the Management and Utilization of Surfing Tourism Attraction, it is necessary to stipulate the Decree of Regent concerning The Number of Surfers That Can Surf In The Surfing Area With Limited Carrying Capacity;

**DECISION:**

Concerning :

**FIRST** : The Number of Surfers Who Can Surf in the Area with Limited Carrying Capacity is as follows:

No	Area / Surfing Point	Number of people/day
1	Districts of Pagai Utara Silabu Village/ Macaronis Wave	40

**SECOND** : Surfers or travel agents or surf tour vessels or accommodation managers representing the surfers who will partake in surfing in areas with limited carrying capacity as defined in the **FIRST** dictum, may utilize the waves for surfing under the following conditions:

- a. shall register themselves to the officers of Culture Tourism Youth and Sport Department of Mentawai Islands Regency to obtain schedule of surfing in the intended area, which can be either directly done through Culture Tourism Youth and Sport Department or via email address at [disbudparpora.mentawai@gmail.com](mailto:disbudparpora.mentawai@gmail.com);
- b. surf boats are required to moor using the mooring buoys provided to maintain the safety and comfort of surfing;
- c. mooring schedules on the mooring buoys are set at 08.00 WIB maximum, and for the surf boats that are not moored until the specified time limit, they can be replaced by other surfing boats; and
- d. Permitted days for the surfers of surfing boats are 2 (two) days.

**THIRD** : This decision is applied since the date set.
